1. Go to www.idiscover.cam.ac.uk to search Library catalogues



To **search only within a specific library**, select the Library from the drop list next to the main search box. A drop list will appear by either clicking on the magnifying glass or searching for the item first.

2. The results page



Each result has an icon (or book cover) which you can click on to get a brief description of the item. You can narrow your search by resource type (e.g. articles) or by Library if you haven't already done so. The number of results is shown at the top of the results list If you can't get to the University Library to get a printed version of the book, **iDiscover** can tell you if there is a **e-book** version available.
